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

- 01) BRC in Zoology will consist of 05 Modules namely BRC ZOO 001/002/003/004 ; each carrying 20 Marks and Practical (05) Carrying 20 Marks.
 - 02) BRC in Zoology will have a total of 100 Marks.
 - 03) Students, enrolled for B.Sc.-Part I in Zoology. such students shall have to complete the relevant module.
 - 04) Teaching of BRC in Zoology will be conducted in the N.H. College through contact hours for lectures and/ or self-study by students, as per the allotted time table of the Zoology Dept.


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Scheme for Examination for BRC in Zoology: -

General Instructions: -

- 01) 05 Modules of BRC in Zoology shall carry a total of 100 Marks comprising 80 Marks in theory papers and 20 Marks in practical exam.
- 02) Examination of BRC in Zoology (Theory Papers and practical marks) shall be conducted by the Dept. of Zoology of N.H College.
