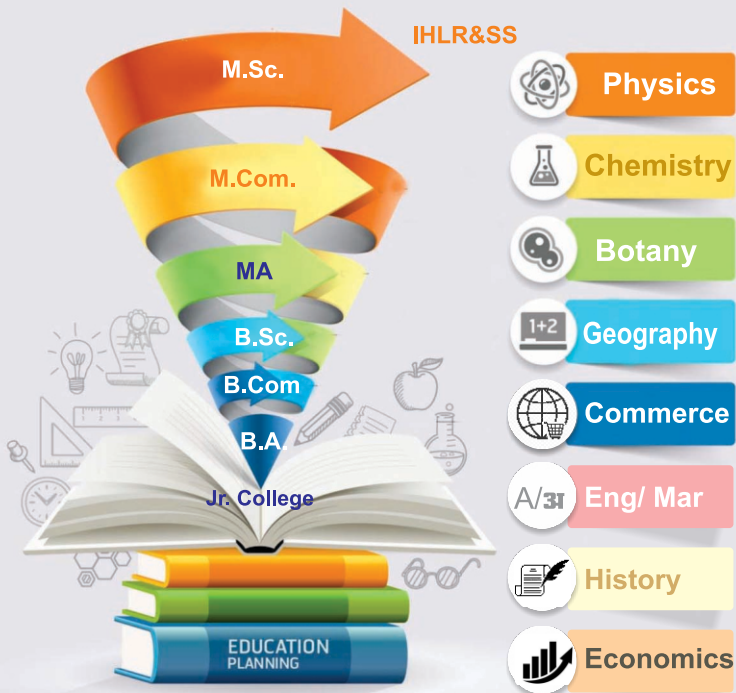

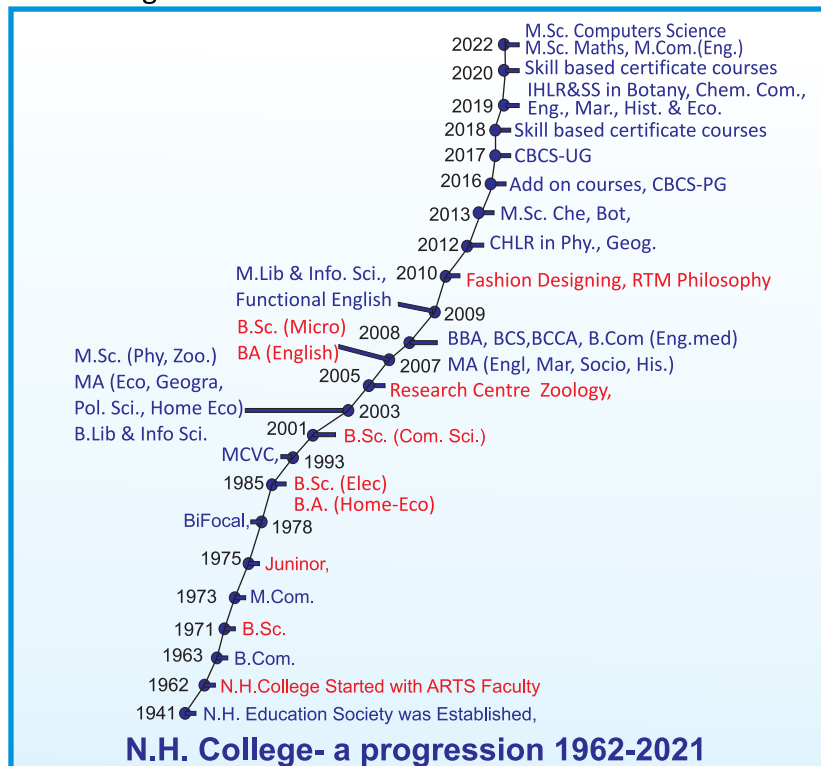

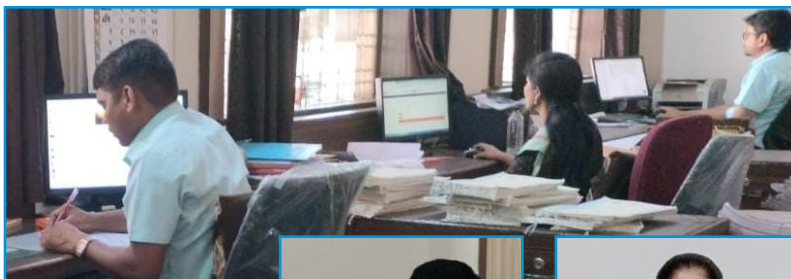

 - 3) The amount of fees and items of fees may change without notice if University changes the fee structure.
 - 4) **EBC/ PTC/ STC concessions are not applicable to PG Non-Grant courses.**
 - 5) **Students coming from professional courses are not eligible for any type of concession or scholarship.**

According to Board of Technical Exam. Circular No. BTC/D-44/DA/95/5619 Mumbai dated 22-06-1995, a student passing with Bi-focal Vocational Courses Comp. Science & Electronics, will be eligible for admission to second year of Polytechnic College in the related discipline.

Following fees (in Rupees) are to be deposited at the time of admission for the First term. The second installment of Tuition Fees, if applicable (Rs. 96 for XI & Rs. 108 for XII), should be paid in the first week of second term.

- Note:**
- For eligibility of RSTF (Rajashree Shahu Tution Fee) the income of parents/ guardians should not be more than Rs 8,00,000/- per Annum.
 - For a girl student there will be no tuition fee provided she submits the required declaration form within 15 days of her Admission.
 - In case of a student eligible for RSTF, he/she must submit the required form within 15 days of his/her admission.
 - If any application for RSTF/Scholarship/any other concession is rejected by competent officer, the concerned student will have to deposit full fees immediately.
 - A student leaving the college in the mid-term will have to pay full fee for one term or two terms as the case may be.
 - All the final year students (UG & PG), leaving the college has to become the member of Alumni Association of N.H. College by Paying Rs. 1000/- for life Membership or Rs. 100/- for Annual Membership.

A) ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

- i) The Admission for UG/PG shall be made ON-LINE for Gondwana University, Gadchiroli.
- ii) Facilities for filling admission forms on-line, their submission and **counseling for parents and students** are made available in the college *free of cost*.
- iii) All the information regarding admission process will be displayed on Notice Board.

B) NECESSARY DOCUMENTS FOR ADMISSION

- 1) Original and attested Xerox copies of School/College Leaving Certificate, Mark list of Qualifying Examination, Character Certificate. eligibility certificate, Migration Certificate, Two Passport size Photographs.
- 2) Attested Xerox copy of Caste Certificate only for Students of Reservation Category.
- 3) **Attested two Xerox copy of ADHAR CARD & Bank Account is necessary for all the students of Junior, UG & PG and Election card is necessary fo all UG & PG.**
- 4) Handi-cap student - Handicap Certificate Xerox Copy.

C) RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1) The fees deposited will not be refunded.
- 2) All the rights regarding admitting or not admitting a student in the college and taking action against a student (including rustication) in any case of misconduct are with the Principal and his decisions will be final in such cases.
- 3) Examination Fee:- The students will have to deposit the required examination fee of Board/University with the cashier and pay all dues at the time of submitting the examination forms.
- 4) **Identity Card :- The students should wear their identity cards in the college premises.** If lost, duplicate card will be issued on deposit of Rs.50/.
- 5) Students availing RSTF/Scholarship/Freeship need not pay the tuition fee at the time of admission. It will be recovered from the concerned Government Department. In case it is not recovered, the concerned student will be responsible for the payment of such fee amount.
- 6) If some amount of fee approved by the University/Board is not recovered from the concerned Govt. Department, the same will be recovered the student. (Specially fees like library / laboratory / other fees)

- 7) The students belonging to minority communities are entitled for Scholarship. (Ceiling of annual income for eligibility is Rs. 2,00,000/- & marks above 50%).
- 8) **Student availing the Minority Scholarship have to pay full fees (Tuition fee, Admission fee & other fees).**
