- 5) For **Rajashri Shahu Maharaj Tutior Fee Scholarship**- Income limit is **8 Lac.**
- 6) **The fee structure for granted UG & PG courses may vary according to new guidelines, if issued by GUG.**

Following fees (in Rupees) are to be deposited at the time of admission for the First term. The second instalment of Tuition Fees, if applicable (Rs. 400/- for UG & Rs. 500 for M.Com.), should be paid in the first week of the second term.

NOTE:

- 1) B.A.I, B.Sc. II, B.Com. II students have to pay Rs.150/-for compulsory six months course in Environment Studies.
- 2) The final year student has to pay Rs. 300/- as fee for University Degree at the time of submission of examination forms and Rs. 100/- as Alumni Member
- 3) The amount of fees and items of fees may change without notice if the University changes the fee structure.
- 4) EBC/ PTC/ STC concessions are not applicable to PG Non-Grant courses.
- 5) Students coming from professional courses are not eligible for any type of concession or scholarship.

Caution Money Refund:

Students are advised to collect caution money within 3 years from the date of leaving the college. Otherwise their claim stand forfeited and it will be used to enhance the books in the library and apparatus, equipment's, chemicals etc. for various laboratory.

GENERAL INFORMATION

A) ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

- 1) The Admission for UG/PG shall be made ON-LINE for Gondwana University, Gadchiroli.
- 2) Facilities for filling admission forms online, their submission and counselling for parents and students are made available in the college free of cost.
- 3) All the information regarding the admission process will be displayed on Notice Board.
- 4) Students are advised to open an ABC ID using their Aadhaar number linked to a mobile number.

B) NECESSARY DOCUMENTS FOR ADMISSION

- 1) Original and attested Xerox copies of School/College Leaving Certificate, Mark list of Qualifying Examination, Character Certificate, eligibility certificate, Migration Certificate, Two Passport size Photographs.
- 2) Attested Xerox copy of Caste Certificate only for Students of Reservation Category.
- 3) Attested two Xerox copies of ADHAR CARD & Bank Account is necessary for all the students of UG & PG and Election card is necessary for all UG & PG.
- 4) ABC ID of the student.
- 5) Handi-cap student - Handicap Certificate Xerox Copy.

C) RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1) The fees deposited will not be refunded.
- 2) All the rights regarding admitting or not admitting a student in the college and taking action against a student (including rustication) in any case of misconduct are with the Principal and his decisions will be final in such cases.
- 3) Examination Fee:- The students will have to deposit the required examination fee of the Board/University with the cashier and pay all dues at the time of submitting the examination forms.

4) Identity Card :- The students should wear their identity cards in the college premises. If lost, duplicate card will be issued on deposit of Rs.50/.

- 5) Students availing EBC/Scholarship/Freeship need not pay the tuition fee at the time of admission. It will be recovered from the concerned Government Department. In case it is not recovered, the concerned student will be responsible for the payment of such fee amount.
- 6) If some amount of fee approved by the University/Board is not recovered from the concerned Govt. Department, the same will be recovered the student. (Specially fees like library/laboratory / other fees)
- 7) If any form for EBC / Scholarship/ Freeship is rejected due to any reason whatsoever, the concerned student will have to deposit the required fee – amount immediately
- 8) If a student leaves the college in the first term or second term, he/she will have to pay full fee for the first term or second term as the case may be. A student will not be issued any certificate without the payment of all dues against his/her name.

D) IMMIGRATION FEE

(These Fees may change)

1. Rs. 200/-: Students coming from Board other than M.S. Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education, Pune & seeking admission to Gondwana University, Gadchiroli.
2. Rs. 500/-: Students coming from other University to Gondwana University, Gadchiroli.
3. Rs. 800/-: Students coming from other country to this Board/University.

E) CONCESSIONS AND SCHOLARSHIPS

1. A student whose parent/guardian has an annual income of not more than Rs 8,00,000/- can avail RSTF facility which includes reimbursement of full tuition fee and some part of admission fee.
2. Scholarships are available for students belonging to SC, ST, NT, OBC, SBC, Ceiling of income for eligibility is Rs. 1,50,000/- for OBC, NT, SBC and Rs. 2,50,000 /-for SC, and for ST Rs. 2,50,000/-.
3. Fee concession is available for students of Freedom Fighters, Primary School Teachers and Secondary School Teachers (PTC, STC).
4. Open Merit Scholarship is available for exceptionally high-scoring students.
5. Physically disabled students can also apply for scholarships by Submitting the prescribed application form. 3% Seats are reserved for handicapped students and they can also apply for scholarships.
6. The students belonging to minority communities are entitled for Scholarships. (Ceiling of annual income for eligibility is Rs. 2,00,000/- & marks above 50%).
7. Students availing the Minority Scholarship have to pay full fees (Tuition fee, Admission fee & other fees).

F) GUIDELINES FOR FILLING SCHOLARSHIP FORMS :

1. Online Scholarship: Students should submit their Scholarship form online (Compulsory).
2. Scholarship for the hostellers will be available only to those producing certificates of hostel approved by the Special District Social Welfare Officer, Chandrapur; Gondwana University, Gadchiroli and N.H. College Bramhapuri. If this condition is not fulfilled his form will be sent to the Special District Social Welfare officer as a 'Day School'.
3. Scholarship form must be submitted within 15 days from the date of admission.
4. Freeship students belonging to Reserved Category: whose parents are having annual income of more than Rs 1,50,000/- for OBC, NT, SBC and Rs. 2,50,000/ (Attach Income Certificate) for SC, ST. should fill out form for Freeship in place of G.O.1. Scholarship forms, Form No.16 if Parent is in Service.
5. The scholarship forms must accompany the following attested Xerox Copies of the Mark List, School/ College Leaving Certificate, Caste Certificate from the Executive Magistrate, Income Certificate (Original), Salary Certificate giving details of the Basic Pay, D.A., H.R.A., etc. (Form No. 16 if Parent is in Service). Non-creamy layer is essential for OBC, VJ-NT & SBC category.

6. Student availing the scholarship facility must open his account in the State Bank of India, Bramhapuri Branch before submitting his scholarship form.
7. Adhar card linking to a Bank account is compulsory for all students.
8. After approval of the scholarship form student must Press "REDEEM" Button in the Student Login. Otherwise, Scholarship will not be paid to the student and the Full fee will be recovered.

G) Rajeshri Shahau Maharaj Tuition Fee/Scholarship

All the students of open category or students of any category whose annual income is below 8,00,000 are eligible for this Scholarship.

H) Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Hostel Nirwah Allowance.

Students residing in Hostel are eligible for Hostel Nirwah allowance. Such students should apply online through proper format of application.

I) GUIDELINES FOR FILLING EBC/PTC/STC FORMS

1. RSTF form and Income Certificate in Two copies should be submitted by the students within 15 days from the date of admission.
2. New students have to fill fresh forms while old students have to fill continuation forms for RSTF.
3. If the parent/guardian is in-service, the student must submit the certificate indicating Basic Pay from the employer.
4. The student whose parent is a Primary School Teacher or Secondary School Teacher must submit P.T.C./S.T.C.form within 15 days from the date of admission.

J) Scholarships Sponsored by the Institute:

- i) Academic Excellence Scholarship (For Meritorious students)


