Solid Waste Management

College appointed a person to collect the solid waste like Leaf litter, breaking glass material, plastics material, metal and woods. Liquid Waste Management

Finally it is collected separate artificial pond where it percolates. Rest of the sewage from other laboratories and wash room is directed through underground drainage and it is utilized for trees.

E-Waste Management

The disposal of E-Waste is a rapidly growing problem because electronic equipment frequently contains hazardous substances which affect the environment and human health.

Under the guidance of principal, Electronics and Computer Science Department collect the old or outdated and non working electronics/electrical equipment from other department. The eradication policy of such devices as follows :

1. If old or outdated device in working condition and no use of it in the department, it is transferred to another department where it required.

2. If device is non-working condition, testing is done at primary level in electronics department.

i) After testing and troubleshooting the problem, and if device is ok, it is returned to the corresponding department.

ii) If it is not ok, troubleshoot the device to next level i.e. circuit level.

iii) After all attempt of troubleshooting, the device is not repair, it is sent to the technician.

iv) If faulty device is not repaired by technician and return from them, spare part of the circuit or component is used in other circuit or project.

3. Excess E-Waste which cannot be reused, is scrapped.
