

## Rules for ATKT Science

<b>B.Sc. (CBCS)</b>		
<b>Admission to Semester</b>	<b>Candidates should have passed in all subjects of following examination</b>	<b>The admission to the program shall be subjected ATKT rules as given below:</b>
SEMESTER I	XII <sup>th</sup> Class or Equivalent	
SEMESTER II	---	a) A students shall be allowed to keep term for semester II irrespective of grades obtained in each of Semester I
SEMESTER III	---	b) A students shall be allowed to keep term for semester III if he/she passes(grade E or above in each course) each of Semester I & Semester II or He/She passes two subject in each semester.
SEMESTER IV	---	c) A student shall be allowed to keep term for semester IV irrespective of grades obtained in each course of Semester III & can appear for Semester IV examination.
SEMESTER V	Semester I & II	d) A student shall be allowed to keep term for semester V, if He/She pases semester I, II, III & IV. Or He/She has passed Semester I & Semester II and Pass at least one subject from Semester III & IV.
SEMESTER VI	---	e) A student shall be allowed to keep term for Sem. VI (with irrespective of grades obtained in each course of Semester V.

<b>Admission to Semester</b>	<b>Rules</b>	
SEMESTER I	As provided in the4 para 4 of the University M.Sc. (CBCS) Direction	
SEMESTER II	Candidate should have appeared in semester I of University Examination.	
SEMESTER III	For Practical Subjects: Candidate should have passed at least 8 papers out of 12 in semester I and II together including practical's. For non-practical subject (e.g. Math) : Candidate should have passed at least 6 papers out of 10 in semester I and II together.	
SEMESTER IV	Candidate should have passed at least one paper out of semester III of University Examination.

SEMESTER V	Semester I & II	Candidate should have passed Sem.I & Sem.II and 40% subject of Semester III & IV.
SEMESTER VI	---	Candidate Should have appeared in at least 01 Theory paper of Semester V.
